

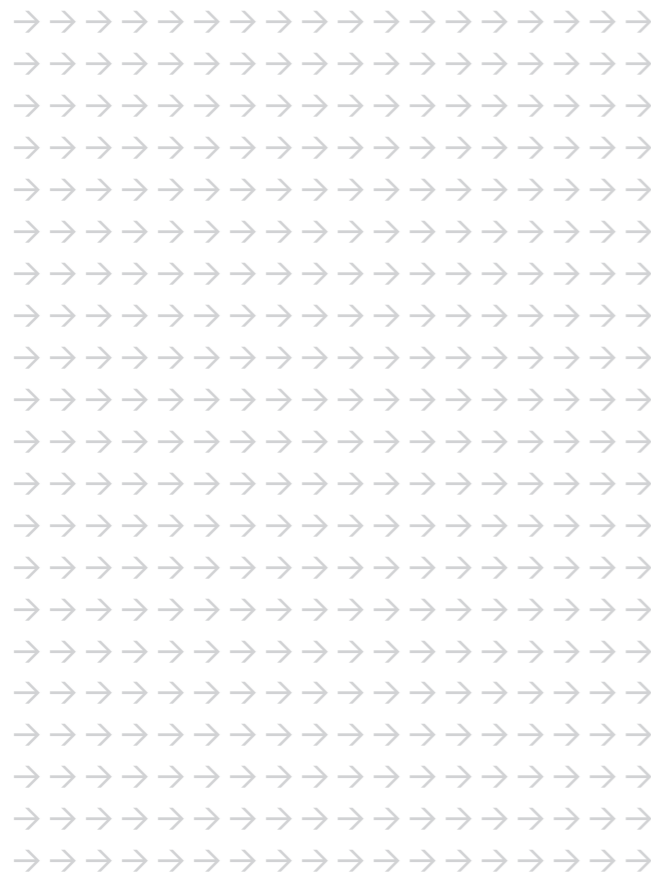
# EASTERN REGIONAL Council Charter 2009
