

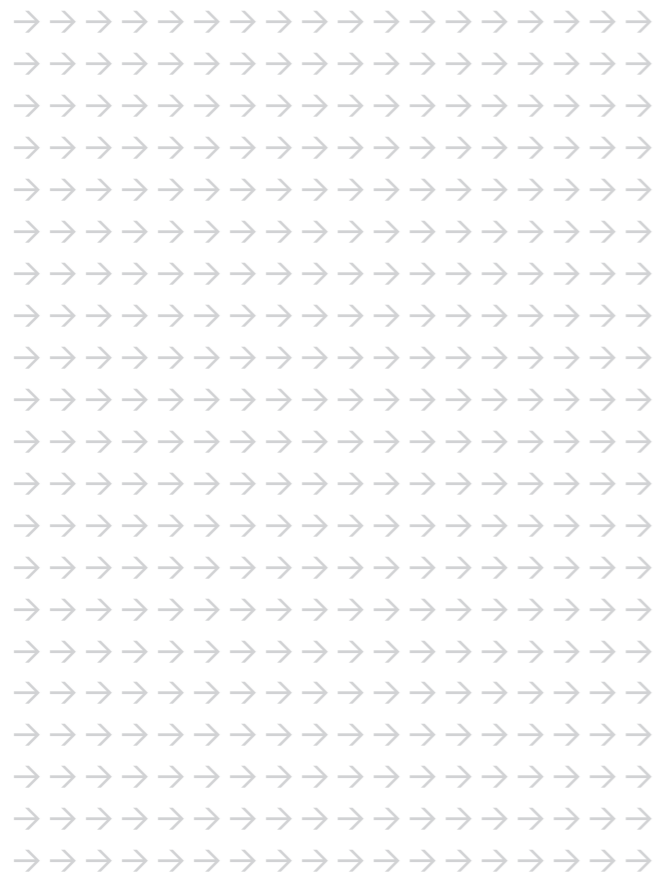
# NORTH WEST REGIONAL Council Charter 2009
