Why use CME to process your Police History Checks?

- Competitive cost of \$38.50 (ex GST) per Police History Check.
- Personalised CME members only service with direct access to the Administrator.
- · Secure and confidential.
- Police History Check results provided directly to CME by the Australian Criminal Intelligence Commission.

How to use the CME National Police Checking Service?

The service is available to all CME members as follows:

Existing Members

Existing CME members are able to utilise the NPCS subject to entering into a standard services agreement with CME for the provision of the service.

New Members

CME has established a new category of membership specifically for Small Business Associates that service the resources sector and wish to utilise the CME National Police Checking Service only. There is a nominal annual subscription fee for this category of membership.

Once membership is confirmed, members will then need to enter into a standard services agreement with CME for the provision of the service. The terms and conditions of the services agreement are the standard contractual requirements of ACIC for the provision of the National Police Clearance Service.

Membership in the Small Business Associate category provides access to the NPCS only.
